The next day the children came back and asked Nothing if he wanted to play with them. Nothing said, “Something”.



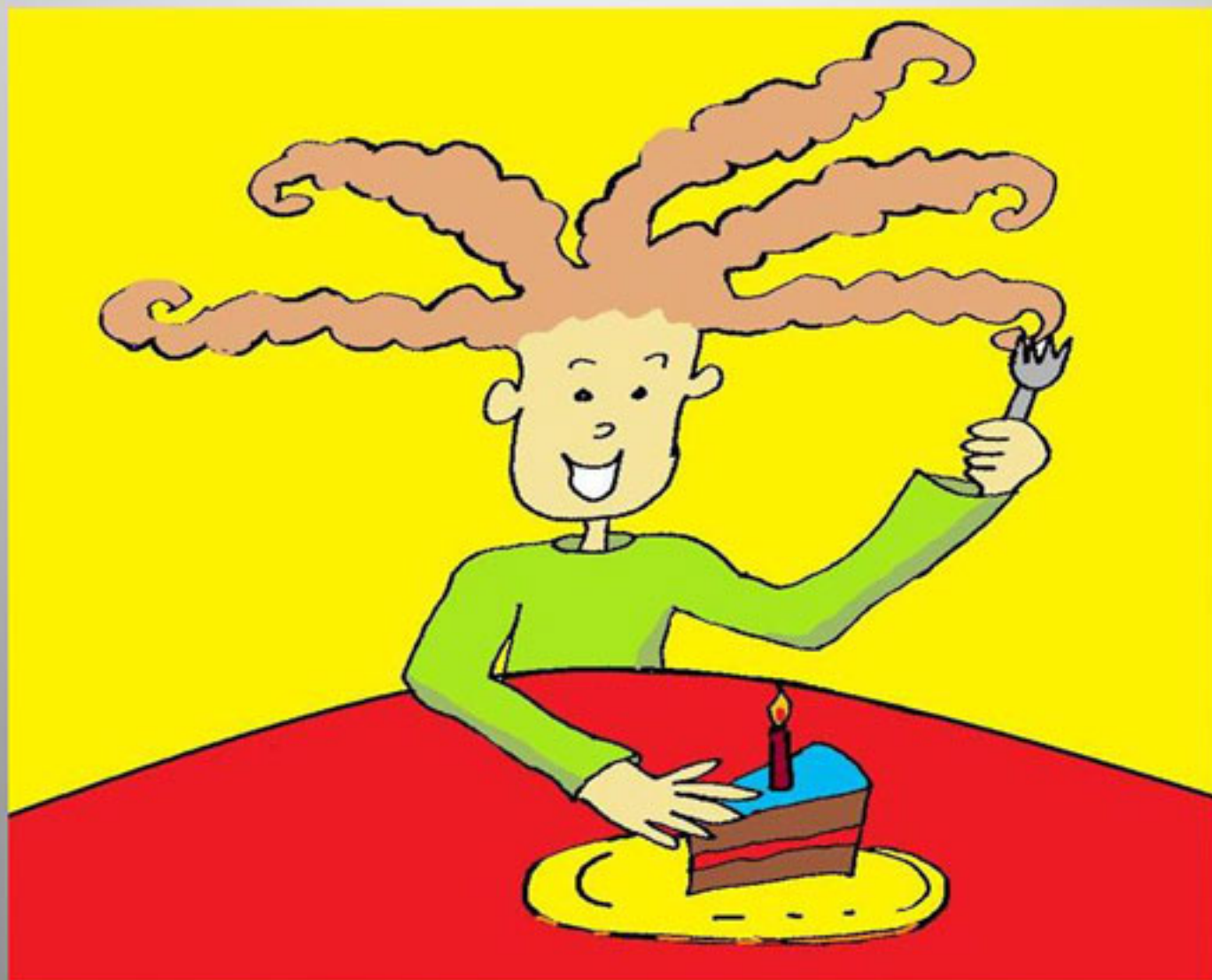
Nothing went off to play with his new friends.
